BLUE ROCK STATE PARK

Somewhat intense riding. Not a park for unconditioned horses. Trail maps fairly easy to follow.

Directions: GPS – 7924 Cutler Lake Rd., Blue Rock, OH 43720. This GPS address unfortunately takes you down undesirable narrow roads when you get into the area. Take 71 or 77 south to Rt. 70. Depending on your choice, proceed E or W to Exit #155 Rt. 60 and head south 9.2 miles to Cutler Lake Road & turn left S. It is a narrow twisty, nicely paved road that brings you to Horseman's Camp on Corns Road on the right. There is a hard right turn onto Corns that most rigs are able to swing. If not, continue down to the parking lot at the beach, swing around & come back so as to hit Corns Road on a straight path.

Reservations: Not required but recommended. It is \$16 per night plus \$8 reservation fee. These are all non-electric sites. Google Blue Rock State Park, click "website"

<u>Amenities:</u> All sites have tie lines. Water is available at 4 strategic places. Decent pit toilets are available in two locations. Coin-operated showers are available at the beach house. Dump station available upon exiting campground!
